## **Enduring authority to remove NAIT tags**

Enduring authority may only be granted to an accredited entity dealing with NAIT animals and will apply only for the duration of their accreditation (subject to renewal).

Where enduring authority has been granted, an entity is permitted to remove and replace a NAIT tag only in the below circumstances, when the need arises:

- An animal is tagged with a faulty/damaged tag that is unable to be scanned with an electronic reader.
- An animal is tagged with a secondary tag (double tagged).
- An animal's ear has become infected and tag removal and replacement is required for animal welfare reasons.

Following a tag removal and replacement of the NAIT tag, the Accredited Entity PICA or someone authorised on behalf of the Entity PICA, must perform a tag replacement in the NAIT Information System.

In accordance with Schedule 2 Clause 19 of the National Animal Identification and Tracing Act 2012, it is an offence to remove a NAIT tag from a live animal unless authorised, and it is an offence to alter, deface or re-use a NAIT tag.
