

# Pre-movement guide

Sending herd location is **within a Movement Control Area (MCA)**

If the animals are moving within a herd (all animals are managed as 1 unit) and within the same NAIT number, then no pre-movement testing required. All parcels within that NAIT number are treated as being under Movement Control Restrictions.

Animals that have been pre-movement tested cannot be tested again within 60 days. Stock can move within 60 days of first test without having to re-test or obtain a permit.

Pre-movement testing is OSPRI's preferred option. But if unable to pre movement test, then you **MUST** contact OSPRI Support Centre as, you may be eligible for a permit to move. If a permit is granted and the receiving herd is outside of an MCA, the receiving herd will be placed on movement restrictions under an Official Directive, until Post-MT is completed.

Selling	I'm sending my animals directly to the <b>meat processor</b> .	No, don't need a Pre-MT.	If the animals returned home, contact the OSPRI Support Centre for next steps.
	I'm sending my animals to a cull sale at a <b>saleyard</b> .	Yes, need a Pre-MT.	Because they were tested before leaving the property, and provided they are within 60 days of their last test - <b>No, don't need a Pre-MT</b>
	I am selling my animals to <b>another person</b> or <b>saleyard</b> .		
Sending to my runoff or another of my farms	I'm grazing my animals on my own runoff block, <b>under the same NAIT</b> and <b>herd number</b> (managed as one herd).	No, don't need a Pre-MT.	<b>No, don't need a Pre-MT.</b>
	I'm grazing my animals on my own runoff/farm, under the same NAIT number but <b>different herd number</b> (managed as separate herds).	Yes, need a Pre-MT. Best practice is to create a new <b>NAIT</b> number.	Second herd number is within MCA - <b>Yes, need a Pre-MT.</b> Second herd number is outside MCA - <b>No, don't need a Pre-MT.</b>

Second herd number is within MCA - <b>Yes, need a Pre-MT.</b> Second herd number is outside MCA - <b>No, don't need a Pre-MT.</b>

# Pre-movement guide

Sending herd location is **outside a Movement Control Area (MCA) going to an MCA**

If the animals are moving within a herd (all animals are managed as 1 unit) and within the same NAIT number, then no pre-movement testing required. All parcels within that NAIT number are treated as being under Movement Control Restrictions.

Animals that have been pre-movement tested cannot be tested again within 60 days. Stock can move within 60 days of first test without having to re-test or obtain a permit.

Pre-movement testing is OSPRI's preferred option. But if unable to pre movement test, then you **MUST** contact OSPRI Support Centre as, you may be eligible for a permit to move. If a permit is granted and the receiving herd is outside of an MCA, the receiving herd will be placed on movement restrictions under an Official Directive, until Post-MT is completed.

	I'm grazing my animals at <b>my/organisation</b> runoff block/farm, <b>which grazes other herds</b> .	Need to create a <b>herd</b> number. No, don't need a Pre-MT.	
Sending to another grazier	I'm sending my animals to a grazier, who will be in charge of my animals while grazing. The grazing block is under the <b>grazier's who has their own NAIT number and herd number</b> .	No, don't need a Pre-MT.
