What are the benefits of traceability?

The importance of traceability

The four main parts of traceability are:


- biosecurity
- food safety
- market assurance and access
- animal health surveillance.

It is a legal requirement to register your cattle and deer within the NAIT information system.



What is the obligation to register?

Each person in charge of cattle and deer must register every location where their cattle and deer are physically located. This will generate a NAIT location number.








Unique NAIT number for every location


Registering every location will provide you with a unique NAIT number for each location.

You will need this number to:

- order NAIT tags
- register your cattle and deer, and
- record movements.


Registering a NAIT location Providing additional information

When registering a NAIT location number, information you must provide includes:

- a property name (which is displayed to other NAIT users)
- a primary production type
- an enterprise type

OSPRI

- an approximate tally of tagged and untagged animals
- any non-NAIT animals on property.

Moving locations? What happens to your NAIT location number?


When moving properties, your NAIT location number doesn't transfer to the new location. It is locked to the location it was registered at.

You will need to register your new location with NAIT before moving your cattle and deer.
